## 2016 EXAMINATIONS REPORT

### GCSE RESULTS

#### Progress 8

Performance tables from 2016 have changed significantly. They will no longer focus on the percentage of students meeting threshold measures i.e. %5A\*-C, and instead, will publish our Progress 8 and Attainment 8 results. This will measure progress from Key Stages 2-4 in Maths, English (both double weighted) 3 EBACC subjects and 3 other valued subjects. The threshold for schools of concern will be -0.5 and we await announcement on the progress definition for coasting schools. The national average is 0.

- Indicative score for 2016 is 0.55 showing that on average students achieve over half a grade better at Parkstone than similar students at other providers.
- This is in the top 2% of all secondary schools nationally for progress.
- Attainment 8 grade is 69.69 (A-).

#### Value Added

This measure is likely to now be replaced in RAISE with Progress and Attainment 8 but provides us with an indication of progress prior to the publication of Progress 8.

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### English Baccalaureate (EBacc)

This is a performance measure on which the school is publically reported. It measures the number of students who achieve at least a C grade in English Language, Maths, Science, a Language and a Humanities subject (excluding Religious Studies).

Parkstone has a free option system and encourages breadth of study across the 16 possible option subjects. As a result of this, and that our highly successful RS results will not count, we will not score exceptionally highly on this measure. Our Ebacc figure for 2016 is 49.1%.

### Vulnerable Groups

We measure the performance of 'vulnerable groups' of students against the average. In this cohort we had 9 girls on Free School Meals (FSM) or Services Child. These children are provided with additional funding through the Pupil Premium. All students gained 5 A\*-C including English and Maths. 64.3% (69.2%) achieved the EBACC.

### YEAR 13 ADVANCED LEVEL RESULTS

Retention in the sixth form is excellent with 100% of girls continuing from year 12 to 13 in 2016 and 86% of year 11 students continuing from year 11 to 12.

We are very pleased with this year's A Level results which again show extremely high attainment. This year's results down slightly on 2015 by 3% A\*-B grades. The pass mark (A\*-E) was 99.8% with only 1 U grade across Year 13 students. Predictions were very accurate reflecting a focus for this academic year.

### YEAR 12 AS RESULTS

Despite the significant changes our overall AS results at AS are excellent. The A-E pass rate is 98.7% with a reduced number of U grades (8) than previous years (2015 22; 2014 25; 2013 43; 2012 27). The A-B grades are at 68%.
